If you are making:

Lasagna – Please make in a disposable pan to serve 10-12 people. Cook completely and deliver hot to the LHS cafeteria between 4:00 and 4:30. (If your work schedule would make it difficult to cook the lasagna, please let me know so we can make arrangements for someone to do this for you). Please label if meatless.

Salad – any type of garden salad is fine—needs to serve 10-12 people. Please include a bottle of dressing (Italian or Ranch) on the side. Please label your bowl if you are not making in a disposable container. Deliver to LHS cafeteria between 4:00 and 4:30. If you have a problem with this delivery time, please let me know.

Desserts – cookies, cakes, brownies, pies. Anything is fine. Label your container if you need it back. Drop off at the LHS cafeteria between 4:30 and 5:00 or your child may bring it to the music room that day if your dessert doesn't require refrigeration.
